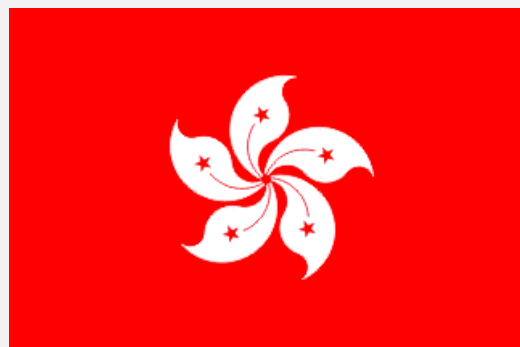

Year	Event
1853	The establishment of first formalised scheme of in-service teacher training commences in St. Paul's College
1881	First Government Normal School established
1994	HKIED was formally established by legislation
1996	HKIED came under the aegis of the University Grants Committee
2016	The Institute was retitled “ <u>The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK)</u> ”

Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme

➤ Eligibility

New full-time PhD students in the eight universities in HK including the Education University of Hong Kong, irrespective of their country of origin, prior work experience, and ethnic background.

➤ Fellowship Award (**Deadline: 1 Dec, 2017**)

Monthly Stipend (2017/18)	Conference and research-related travel allowance
HK\$20,000 (approximately US\$2,500)	HK\$10,000 per year (approximately US\$1,300) up to 3 years
